Holy or Holiness - is Total Devotion. (God commands us to be Perfect & Holy, Matt. 5:48 & 1 Pet. 1:16, etc....)

There is an equation (a very simple equation!) that will clear up all confusion over Bible verses about salvation. The equation is called "The Salvation Equation", and it reveals that salvation is a dichotomous issue, meaning "having two parts". Each part is equally important and absolutely necessary for a person to obtain salvation (eternal life). One part is your part and the other part is God's part. Therefore, the equation looks like this:

The Salvation Equation

$$A \text{ (Your Part)} + B \text{ (God's Part)} = C \text{ (Eternal Life)}$$

Note: In the equation, "A" is some number greater than zero, and "B" is some number greater than zero. It looks like this in math symbols: $A > 0$, $B > 0$. Therefore, "A" will never equal "C" ALONE, nor will "B" ever equal "C" ALONE. But rather, it will ALWAYS take "A" + "B" TOGETHER to equal "C".

Term "A"

So what is term "A" in the equation? In other words, what is YOUR part in obtaining salvation (eternal life)? Are you ready? It is to REPENT OF SIN! But what is that exactly? How do you do it? Well, here's the definition of the original Greek word "*metanoēō*" which was translated "repent" in our English New Testament Bibles: to repent, to change any or all of the elements composing one's life: attitude, thoughts, and behaviors concerning the demands of God for right living. Wow! So what are the "demands of God for RIGHT living"? Friend, they are the 10 Love Commandments! "Right living" is accomplished ONLY by obeying (keeping) God's 10 Love Commandments. So that's it. That's your part, my part, and any man or woman who has

ever lived(s) part in obtaining eternal life. Nothing else you do, know, or believe will get you to heaven, ONLY your REPENTANCE.

Furthermore, repentance is NOT a onetime decision. Rather, it is a continual lifestyle of love (keeping of God's 10 Love Commandments) that if one ever willingly turns away from doing, will NOT allow their soul to obtain eternal life (salvation). In other words, our part in obtaining salvation is a continual way, a path, a battle, a fight, and it only ends when we breathe our last breath on Earth. Understand? Here now are some Scripture verses that utilize the word "salvation" that are talking about YOUR duty in the Salvation Equation.

"My defense is of God, which saveth the upright in heart" ([Psalms 7:10](#))

"The Lord is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit" ([Psalms 34:18](#))

"Salvation is far from the wicked: for they seek not thy statutes" ([Psalms 119:155](#))

"Lord, I have hoped for thy salvation, and done thy commandments" ([Psalms 119:166](#))

"I have longed for thy salvation, O Lord; and thy law is my delight" ([Psalms 119:174](#))

"Again, when the wicked man turneth away from his wickedness that he hath committed, and doeth that which is lawful and right, he shall save his soul alive" ([Ezekiel 18:27](#))

"And Zacchaeus stood, and said unto the Lord; Behold, Lord, the half of my goods I give to the poor; and if I have taken any thing from any man by false accusation, I restore him fourfold. And Jesus said unto him, This day is salvation come to this house" ([Luke 19:8-9](#))

"And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved. And for this cause God shall send them a strong delusion, that they should believe a lie: That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness" ([II Thessalonians 2:10-12](#))

"For godly sorrow worketh repentance to salvation." ([II Corinthians 7:10](#))

"Work out your own salvation with fear and trembling." ([Philippians 2:12](#))

Term “B”

Alright, so what is term “B” in the Salvation Equation? In other words, what is GOD’S part in you obtaining salvation (eternal life)? It is to FORGIVE YOUR SINS! But why is that necessary? How does that work? This, my friend, is where the story of what Jesus Christ did on the cross comes in. Listen, every one of us has sinned (disobeyed one of God’s 10 Love Commandments) at one time or another in our life, and even just one little sin has a consequence (or a price to be paid) under God’s righteous law. Do you know what that price is? It’s eternal spiritual death in hell. This is why the Apostle Paul wrote: “For the wages of sin is death” (Romans 6:23). Consequently, since we’ve ALL sinned at least once, we ALL deserve death. None of us deserve to be “saved” from hell and obtain eternal life in heaven. So how are any of us ever going to obtain it? Well, this is where God comes in!

God devised an amazing plan of salvation for mankind. Almost 4,000 years into the history of mankind, He chose to impregnate a virgin woman on Earth with His righteous Holy Spirit seed, and she gave birth to a sinless child who would grow up to be the Savior of mankind’s souls. This child was/is Christ Jesus, our Lord. He never sinned once, which means he always kept God’s 10 Love Commandments perfectly. Consequently, he would NEVER have had to face the “death sentence” that comes from sinning. He was righteous. He was pure. But in his perfect love for us, he chose to endure the “spiritual death penalty” that comes from sinning. He went through hell for you and me! He was tortured, beat, bruised, and finally crucified on a cross. His righteous soul’s blood was shed. His soul tasted sin’s consequence (separation from God – pain, sorrow, fear, and work) and he cried out: “My God, my God, why hast thou forsaken me?” (Mark 15:34). He was then taken down of the cross, buried, and after three days and nights in the ground ... he arose alive from the grave!

So what does this mean for you and me? It means Jesus Christ paid a death sentence for sin he didn’t owe. And how does that help us? Well, the judge of all mankind, God, looks at it like this ... He is willingly to accept Jesus’ gift (his sinless death) IN PLACE of the death you and I should pay for the sins we’ve committed. Can you imagine that? Amazing, isn’t it? And IF that “divine transfer” happens for you one day, it will mean this ... God has officially “forgiven you of the penalty for your sins” and consequently, you will NOT be sentenced to death in hell, but rather you will be “saved” (obtain salvation) and enter into the joys of eternal life in heaven. Praise His name! Here now are some Scripture verses that utilize the word “salvation” that are talking about GOD’S duty in the Salvation Equation. Enjoy!

“He that is our God is the God of salvation; and unto God the Lord belong the issues from death” ([Psalms 68:20](#))

“Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, O daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King (Jesus) cometh unto thee: he is just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass” ([Zechariah 9:9](#))

“For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord” ([Luke 2:11](#))

“And he (Simeon) came by the Spirit into the temple and when the parents brought in the child Jesus, to do for him after the custom of the law, then took he him up in his arms, and blessed God, and said, Lord, now lettest thou thy servant depart in peace, according to thy word: For mine eyes have seen thy salvation” ([Luke 2:27-30](#))

“For God sent not his Son (Jesus) into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved” ([John 3:17](#))

“For God hath not appointed us to wrath, but to obtain salvation by our Lord Jesus Christ” ([I Thessalonians 5:9](#))

“Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the commandment of God our Saviour, and Lord Jesus Christ, which is our hope” ([I Timothy 1:1](#))

“Therefore I (Paul) endure all things for the elect’s sakes, that they may also obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory” ([II Timothy 2:10](#))

“So Christ was once offered to bear the sins of many; and unto them that look for him shall he appear the second time without sin unto salvation” ([Hebrews 9:28](#))

“And we have seen and do testify that the Father (God) sent the Son (Jesus) to be the Saviour of the world” ([I John 4:14](#))

Repentance FOR Forgiveness

Well, there you have it ... the two Biblical parts “A” & “B” to obtaining “C” (eternal life) in the Salvation Equation. Pretty cool, huh? And it’s real easy to understand, right? So here’s how the equation works: If you do NOT do “A” (your part) which is to “repent of sin” by willingly striving to live each day by God’s 10 Love Commandments, then you will NOT receive “B” (God’s part) which is to “forgive your sins,” and thus, you will NOT obtain “C” (eternal life). But on the other hand, if you DO willingly choose to do “A” (repent of your sins) you WILL receive “B” (forgiveness for your sins) and thus, you WILL obtain “C” (eternal life). The Bible has a simple way of saying this — “(Your) Repentance **FOR** (God’s) Forgiveness of Sins”.

Did you notice the word “FOR” in the phrase? It means this ... a person must repent of their sins in order to receive the “forgiveness for sins” God made available to them through Christ Jesus, and thus eternal life. But remember, repentance is NOT just some one time decision! It is a continual lifestyle of fighting and conquering sin in one’s own life (which means to live by God’s 10 Love Commandments). Here now are some verses where the Bible confirms “repentance” AND “forgiveness of sins” are the two necessary components of salvation, with special emphasis on the fact that REPENTANCE is OUR DUTY in obtaining salvation (eternal life).

“Repent, and turn yourselves from ALL your transgressions (sins); so iniquity shall not be your ruin ... make you a new heart and a new spirit” ([Ezekiel 18:30-31](#))

“They that are whole have no need of the physician, but they that are sick: I came not to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance” ([Mark 2:17](#))

“And they (disciples) went out, and preached that men should repent” ([Mark 6:12](#))

“And he (John the Baptist) came into all the country about Jordan, preaching the baptism of repentance FOR the remission (forgiveness) of sins” ([Luke 3:3](#))

“Except ye repent, ye shall ALL likewise perish” ([Luke 13:3](#))

“Likewise, I say unto you there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner that repenteth” ([Luke 15:10](#))

“And that repentance AND remission (forgiveness) of sins should be preached in his name among all nations” ([Luke 24:47](#))

“Repent ... FOR the remission (forgiveness) of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost” ([Acts 2:38](#))

“Repent ye therefore, and be converted, THAT your sins may be blotted out, when the times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord” ([Acts 3:19](#))

“Forasmuch then as we are the offspring of God ... (He) commandeth all men every where to repent: Because He hath appointed a day, in the which He will judge the world” ([Acts 17:29-31](#))

“To open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan unto God, that they MAY receive forgiveness of sins ... they should repent and turn to God” ([Acts 26:18-20](#))

“The Lord is ... not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance” ([II Peter 3:9](#))

What Must I DO to Obtain Eternal Life

What Must I Do

Several times, Scripture records people posing the question to Jesus, “Teacher, what MUST I DO to obtain eternal life?” Notice, the question being asked is NOT, “Teacher, what MUST

GOD DO so that I might obtain eternal life?” This distinction is of PARAMOUNT importance, for the answer is COMPLETELY different depending on which question is being asked!

If asking what WE (as human beings) must DO, the answer is ALWAYS part “A” in the Salvation Equation (“repent of sin” by striving to keep God’s 10 Love Commandments); but if asking what GOD must DO, the answer is ALWAYS part “B” in the Salvation Equation (“forgive our sins” through Christ Jesus’ death). If you understand this, you should be able to understand perfectly Christ’s responses to people’s question, “Teacher, what MUST I DO to obtain eternal life?” Here are his replies:

“If thou wilt enter into life, keep the (10 Love) Commandments ... Thou shalt do no murder, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Honour thy father and thy mother: and, Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself” ([Matthew 19:16-21](#))

“Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy strength, and with all thy mind; and thy neighbour as thyself ... This DO, and thou shalt live” ([Luke 10:25-28](#))

“Thou knowest the commandments, Do not commit adultery, Do not kill, Do not steal, Do not bear false witness, Honour thy father and thy mother” ([Luke 18:18-22](#))

Do you see? Every time Jesus was asked by someone what THEY must DO to obtain eternal life, he ALWAYS put the focus squarely on part “A” of the Salvation Equation, which is to prove one has “repented of sin” by working the “fruits of repentance” – which can be said in any of the four following ways: 1. “Obey (Keep) the 10 Love Commandments” or 2. “Love God with all your heart & love your neighbor as yourself” or 3. “Do unto others as you’d have them to do unto you” or 4. Just speak (list) the 10 Love Commandments. All 4 ways are exactly the same in meaning. And why would Jesus respond with these answers? Because he understood the Salvation Equation! He knew the Truth!!!

Warning!

But today I challenge you to ask any minister, “Preacher, what MUST I DO to obtain eternal life?” And do you know what the response will be? Sadly, you will almost ALWAYS here that “preacher” start regurgitating the story of Jesus to you, what he did on the cross, etc. Do you see how wrong this is? The preacher is answering with part “B” in the Salvation Equation (what GOD had to DO) so that you might have eternal life! Absurd!!! That is NOT what you asked. Do you see how incorrect this is? This is as wrong an answer as if I asked you to teach me how to drive a car, and you begin to tell me all about the history of cars, how they were invented, who invented them, etc. Do you see? You’d look at me like I was crazy, and say, “Sir, that’s NOT at

ALL what I asked! I want to know how to DRIVE this car!” Well, my friend, that’s exactly what Satan has done to today’s pastors, completely confusing them about God’s Word. It’s truly remarkable and extremely sad, for people’s eternal destinies are at stake!

Then, these confused preachers will usually finish their story about Jesus, by asking you, “Now, do you believe in Jesus’ story and what he did for you?” If you say yes, they’ll have you recite some words (sinner’s prayer) after them, and then proclaim, “Now you’re saved!” Ugh, do you see the MONSTROUS deception behind all of this? NONE of this is what YOU MUST DO to obtain eternal life! They never told you YOUR part in obtaining eternal life, which was your original question! They never spoke Jesus’ very own words in the Bible to this question. Truly, they never gave you a chance to obtain eternal life, because they never told you the ONLY thing they SHOULD have told you, “If you want to obtain eternal life, you MUST willingly choose to live by God’s 10 Love Commandments the rest of your life!”

Friend, most of today’s salvation doctrine in churchianity is all just one HUGE satanic deception meant to keep you in darkness to the truth and on your way to hell. So, if you get a chance, I urge you (for the loving sake of your fellow man) to point these “preachers” to this 10 Love Commandments website as quickly as possible, so they can learn the FULL TRUTH of salvation.

By Grace Are You Saved Through Faith

Term B is God’s Grace

The word “grace” was translated from the Greek word “charis” meaning: grace, the state of kindness and favor towards someone, often with a focus on a benefit given; by extension, a gift, benefit, or credit. That’s grace! And the word “faith” is from the Greek Word “pistis” meaning: faith, belief, or trust, with an implication that ACTIONS based on that trust will follow; “the faith” often refers to the Christian system of belief and lifestyle.

So looking at our Salvation Equation (SE), can you see where grace and faith fit in? It’s really simple. Term “B” is God’s grace! God’s grace was bestowed upon us in the fact that He sent Jesus to die for us. The Messiah was a gift, a benefit, a credit. Jesus is the fulfillment of God’s grace (kindness and favor) shown toward all of us! Why? Because we can obtain eternal life through him. His righteous death is a worthy sacrifice to pay our death sentence. So what mercy, what love, what GRACE God showered down on us through Jesus. So simply put ... Term B in the SE is the part where God’s grace comes into play. Here’s two verses proving this truth:

“In him we have redemption, or salvation, through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God’s grace” ([Ephesians 1:7](#))

“The grace of God, which is by one man, Jesus Christ, has abounded unto many” ([Romans 5:15](#))

Term A is Our Faith

Alright, so what about “faith”? The Bible says for by grace are you saved THROUGH FAITH. How does faith fit into the SE? Friend, it’s Term “A”! Remember the Greek Word for “faith” implies ACTIONS (WORKS) will be done as a result of that faith. In other words, it’s an action-based faith. It’s the lifestyle of a REAL Christian. And what’s that? It’s love. It’s a person who lives by the 10LC. Keeping the 10LC is the proof of our faith in God, or Jesus. So faith is just Term A all over again, just expressed in a different way. And our faith will win us eternal life, for it’s OUR DUTY in the SE. So let me give you a few verses that confirm our faith only exists by our keeping of the 10LC.

“All that matters is faith, expressing itself through love” ([Galatians 5:6](#))

“Faith without works (of love) is dead” ([James 2:26](#))

It doesn’t get any simpler than that, right? It’s our works (deeds) of love that prove our faith in God. And the deeds of love are the 10LC. The Bible says, “Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love” (I John 4:8). So you see, if you say you “believe in God (who is love)” what you’re really saying is you “believe in love”. So if you believe in love, then you must live by the 10LC, or else you’re a liar.

So listen up, whenever you run across these phrases in the Bible ... faith in Jesus, faith in Christ, faith in God, faith in his name, or believe in Jesus, believe in God, believe in him, whosoever believeth in him ... all of these phrases mean the same thing — They describe a person who lives by the 10LC, for those actions (works) are the PROOF of one’s faith in God, or Jesus.

Friend, [ALL of Jesus’ Teachings](#) were based on “keeping the 10LC” when he was instructing us on how to live to obtain eternal life. So with that in mind, think about the SE as you listen to this verse:

“And being made perfect, Jesus became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him!” ([Hebrews 5:9](#))

How about that? Do you see it? It’s Term A & B in the SE all wrapped up in one verse! If we OBEY the teachings of Jesus, which are the 10LC, we will obtain eternal life through his perfect death! Isn’t it amazing how the SE makes sense of all verses?

So to sum this all up, concerning Paul’s phrase “For by Grace are you saved THROUGH Faith”, just realize these words are expressing both terms in the SE. In fact, saying it this way will help you recognize this truth, “For by GOD’S Grace are you saved through YOUR Faith”. Got it? Your faith is Term A in the SE, and God’s grace is Term B. It’s that simple!

Warning!

And one last thing, please be aware there's a WHOLE LOT of hyper grace doctrine out there today, trying to make you believe you don't have to live right to go to heaven. But it's ALL from the enemy, folks! Don't buy it! It's crap! It will kill you! God's grace is only half the picture of salvation, it's God's part, as the SE clearly reveals. But you still have YOUR part to do — you must prove your faith in God by keeping the 10LC. Together, these two things, will obtain you eternal life!

Not of Works Lest Any Man Should Boast

It's About Circumcision

“Not of works lest any man should boast” is a phrase the Apostle Paul wrote that is spoken ubiquitously in today's church world. I mean it's everywhere! And it's being used incorrectly to make people believe they don't have to live by God's 10LC to make heaven. This is DEAD wrong. And Paul would be livid at this lie! But today's preachers don't care. They're happy to twist his words around to everyone's destruction. Unbelievable! So what's it REALLY about? What REALLY made Paul write “not of works” in some of his letters?

Paul wrote “not of works” because of two main issues of his day — circumcision and food abstinence. That's right, the Old Testament Jewish laws of circumcision and abstaining from eating certain foods, and whether or not those laws needed to be followed for salvation, was the issue at hand that led Paul to write, “it's not of works, lest you should boast!”

Listen, the Jewish religious leaders of Paul's day were adamant about the gentiles needing to be circumcised in order to be saved. This fact is first seen in the book of Acts: “Then some men came down from Judea to Antioch and were teaching the brethren, ‘Unless you are circumcised according to the custom of Moses, you cannot be saved’ (Acts 15:1). Can you imagine? That's what was taking place back in Paul's day! And yet, Paul knew salvation was NOT of those works of the law, for circumcision of the flesh was NOT a 10LC issue. Immediately, Paul picks this subject up in Romans, addressing the Jewish religious leaders in Rome:

“Indeed, you are called a Jew, and rest on the law, and make your BOAST in God ... You, then, who teach others, do you not teach yourself? You who preach against stealing, do you steal? You who say that people should not commit adultery, do you commit adultery? You who abhor idols, but then make money your god instead! You who BOAST in the law, do you dishonor God by breaking the law?

“Circumcision has value if you observe the law (the 10LC), but if you break the law, you have become as though you had not been circumcised. So then, if those who are NOT circumcised keep the law's requirements will they not be regarded as though they were circumcised? The one who is NOT circumcised physically

and yet obeys the law (the 10LC) will condemn you, who, even though you have the written code and circumcision, are a lawbreaker!

“For a person is not a Jew who is one outwardly, nor is circumcision merely outward and physical. No, a person is a Jew who is one inwardly; and circumcision is circumcision of the heart, by the Spirit, not by the written code. Such a person’s praise is not from other people, but from God.” ([Romans 2:17-29](#))

Do you see what was taking place here? The Jews were BOASTING in the fact that their flesh was circumcised. They were PROUD of that! But Paul knew they weren’t keeping God’s 10LC. He was even naming certain of them, specifically. In other words, Paul was making it crystal clear that the 10LC laws were of paramount importance and that circumcision of the flesh was unimportant. Can you see now why Paul would write to these Jews ... “it’s not of works, lest any man should BOAST”? Paul’s dealing with this topic again in his letter to the Corinthians:

“A man who already has gone through the Jewish ceremony of circumcision, before he became a Christian, shouldn’t worry about it; and if he hasn’t been circumcised, he shouldn’t do it now. It doesn’t make any difference at all whether a Christian has gone through this ceremony or not. But it makes a lot of difference whether he is pleasing God by keeping God’s commandments. THAT is the important thing!” ([I Corinthians 7:18-19](#))

Wow! It doesn’t get any clearer than that, does it? And God’s commandments are the 10LC! See, friend, Paul LOVED God’s 10LC. He KNEW they were the laws of love that needed to be kept to prove one’s faith in God. He continuously preached “obedience to them” was the path that leads to eternal life, all throughout his letters. It would take me days to point out all the verses he wrote in support of the 10LC. In other words, he preached the EXACT SAME MESSAGE as Jesus Christ. But all the other laws, all the Jewish laws and customs like circumcision, hand washing, not eating certain “unclean” foods, feast observances, and more, Paul knew those laws were NOT needed for salvation. And thus he wrote, “It’s not of works of the law, lest you should boast!”

Let me take a moment and explain something to you about the word “law” in the New Testament. It’s from the Greek Word “*nomos*” meaning: law, regulation, principle; this has a broad range of meanings and referents, ranging from the OT Scriptures as a body, the first five books of Moses, or any single command of the Scriptures. Friend, this is the Greek word used by Paul all throughout his letters. So here’s the point ... you HAVE to read what Paul is talking about around the word “law” to know what law he’s referring too! They are letters Paul wrote. Letters are meant to be read in their entirety. You have to read them in context. You can’t just pull out a phrase here and there, and then spin it to make it say what YOU want. That’s

dishonest. That's deception. That's what the Devil does! And that's what happening today, all over churchianity.

So I challenge you, whenever you see Paul talking about salvation is "not of works of the law" look at what he's talking about around it. It's almost exclusively the law of circumcision. For instance, in Galatians, Paul writes: "Know that a person is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ" (Galatians 2:16). Well, we learned in part 5 of this series that "the faith of Jesus Christ" is to "keep the 10LC". So what law was Paul talking about that we are NOT going to be justified by? Well, read the first 15 verses of that chapter and you'll see. He said: "But neither Titus, who was with me, being Greek, was compelled to be circumcised. This matter arose because some false believers had infiltrated our ranks to spy on the freedom we have in Christ Jesus and to make us slaves, forcing us to follow their Jewish regulations" (Galatians 2:3-4). Do you see it? It's circumcision! Thirteen times the word comes up in Galatians! Paul was saying you Jews are NOT going to be justified by your keeping of the law of circumcision, but rather by your keeping of the 10LC!

So seriously, check it out. Whenever you find "not of works" in Paul's letters, look around it and see what he's talking about. Romans and Galatians are the two biggest places where Paul uses the phrase, and if you'll look, you'll see what had Paul upset was the Jewish law of circumcision, and the Jew's belief that this was needed for salvation. Ephesians contains the exact phrase we're talking about here today "Not of works lest any man should boast" (Ephesians 2:9) and just two sentences later Paul says: "Now don't forget that you gentiles used to be outsiders. You were called "uncircumcised heathens" by the Jews, who were PROUD of their circumcision, even though it affected only their bodies and not their hearts" (Ephesians 2:11). There you go. It's ALWAYS about circumcision!

Warning!

Let me put all of this to you in a different way, can you imagine a man walking up to Paul and saying "Paul, I'm struggling with the sin of adultery. I've been married 10 years now, but I have a mistress on the side, and I just can't let her go". And Paul leans over, pats the guy on the back and says, "Oh, brother, it's ok, salvation is not of works of the law". Can you imagine? Or how about a thief, or a murderer, or someone full of hatred and unforgiveness, or a greedy person? And Paul just comforts them and says, "Aww ... it's ok, friend, it's not of works. Don't worry about it." Do you see how stupid that is? Paul would NEVER say that to those people! And yet, that is what preachers today are doing when they use the phrase "not of works" in their salvation pitch. You know they're referring to the 10LC! They're saying you don't have to repent and live by the 10LC to make heaven. It's not of works! You can go some other way. Just say this prayer with me. How tragic!

And guess what we NEVER hear out of preachers? The simple words of Jesus Christ, "If you want to obtain eternal life, keep the 10LC". In other words, DO Term A in the SE! Why do Christ's words NEVER come out of their mouths? It's because they're confused. They've been tricked by the devil. I mean Jesus is answering the VERY QUESTION of what WE must DO to obtain eternal life, right there in their own Bible, and yet they cannot repeat his answer during

their salvation pitch! It's STUNNING! Honestly, they don't believe Jesus' words. Therefore, "Keep the 10LC" just will NOT come out of their mouths. They'd rather quote phrases from Paul's letters, completely in error, and leave you as confused and misguided as they are. Satan has done as Peter said, he has twisted Paul's words to their own destruction. It's sick. And I promise you, these preachers will PAY dearly for their deception. For their lies are helping to send people to hell. As for Paul, do you know how many times he said we should be DOING GOOD WORKS to make heaven, meaning keep the 10LC? Oh, over and over again! Why don't preachers grab these phrases out of Paul's letters and parrot them continually during their salvation pitch? Here, listen to some of them:

"For not the hearers of the law are just before God, but the DOERS of the LAW shall be justified!" ([Romans 2:13](#))

"God will repay each person according to what they have done. To those who by patient continuance in doing good, he will give eternal life. But for those who are self-seeking and reject the truth and follow evil, there will be wrath and anger" ([Romans 2:6-8](#))

"I (Paul) preached first to those in Damascus, then in Jerusalem and throughout all Judea, and also to the Gentiles, that ALL must repent of their sins and turn to God – proving they have repented by doing good works" ([Acts 26:20](#))

"Do you not know that the wicked will NOT inherit the Kingdom of God? Do not be deceived: Neither the sexually immoral, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor homosexuals, nor thieves, nor the greedy, nor drunkards, nor verbal abusers, nor swindlers, will inherit the Kingdom of God" ([I Corinthians 6:9-10](#))

Well, you get the point. I could go on and on with verses proving Paul knew "keeping the 10LC" was OUR DUTY in obtaining eternal life. And if we didn't, we wouldn't make it! Friend, just realize Paul was NEVER referring to the 10LC when he used the phrase "not of works". He was referring mostly to the Jewish law of circumcision. But get the irony of this ... the law of circumcision is no longer an issue today in Christianity! No one's debating anymore whether this is necessary for eternal life. So, in other words, Paul's phrase "not of works" (in the context he used it!) is actually no longer relevant to today. It should never even be spoken today. It's a throw away phrase, with no relevance or meaning in today's church world. And yet, sadly, we hear it continually.

So let me wrap this up ... friend, if you hear a preacher today using Paul's phrase "it's not of works" in their salvation pitch, knowing they're referring to the 10LC, implying you do not need to follow them to make heaven, you're listening to a devil! RUN FROM THAT MAN/WOMAN! Turn him/her off your TV! Get them off your computer! Their words are the words of Satan! Rather, listen to the simple, pure and honest words of Jesus Christ, "If you want to obtain eternal life, love God with all your heart and love your neighbor as yourself, which is accomplished by keeping the 10LC! DO THIS, and you will live eternally!"

The Free Gift of Eternal Life

The Free Gift

“*The free gift of eternal life*” is another phrase the Apostle Paul used that has preachers confused today. The argument goes like this ... if eternal life is a gift, then we don't have to do anything, right? I mean, if we have to do something to obtain eternal life, then how's it a gift? See the confusion? So let me clear this issue up today, very easily, by going back to our Salvation Equation (SE).

It's this simple ... the free gift is term “B” in the SE! The Messiah, Jesus Christ's death, was the gift! This is why John 3:16 starts with ... “For God so loved the world that he GAVE his only begotten son.” See the “giving” part? God gave us a gift. Listen, we didn't do ANYTHING to cause God to send the Messiah to die for us. We were all sinners. We didn't deserve it. God did it ONLY because He loved us, and He promised He would. That's it. This is why Paul wrote: “But when the kindness and love of God our Savior appeared, he saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy” (Titus 3:5). See, it wasn't anything we did that made God send Jesus to die for us. It was simply God's gift to all of us. And this gift was God fulfilling his duty, or part B, in the SE.

And please understand ... the REAL GIFT was Christ's death. It's his sinless death, that now sits there available to ALL of us to pay OUR death sentence for the sins we committed. In other words, we can obtain “forgiveness for sins” through Christ's death, and ultimately eternal life. This is why Paul wrote the following verses:

“For the wages of sin is death; but the GIFT of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord” ([Romans 6:23](#))

“There is a great difference between Adam's sin and God's free gift. For the sin of this one man, Adam, brought death to many. But even greater is God's wonderful grace and his gift to many through this other man, Jesus Christ” ([Romans 5:15](#))

See, it's so clear ... Jesus Christ is the gift, and the gift is the evidence of God's grace. This goes right back to part 5 of our series, where I taught you Paul's phrase, “We are saved by God's grace, through Our faith”. Remember, the Greek word for grace meant by extension ... a gift! Well, there you go. Paul is saying ALL OF THAT in this one verse ... God's grace, or kindness, gave us the free gift of the Messiah, Christ Jesus, the one through whose death we can obtain eternal life.

What About Term A

Alright, so what about Term A in the SE? If it's a gift, then why do we still have to do something to obtain eternal life? How does that work? Well, it's like this parable ... A certain man has decided to give you a free gift of one million dollars. You did absolutely NOTHING to

earn it! He's just giving it to you. But here's the deal ... the money is in a safety deposit box in a bank in Portland, Oregon, so if you want it, you'll have to go and get it.

So let's say for example you live in Florida, it might take you two weeks to drive out there and back to get the money. It's going to take your time, money, and energy to go and get the gift. You'll have to spend for gas and lodging along the way, and you'll work hard driving your car thousands of miles. So let me ask you a question ... does this mean the one million dollars is NOT a gift now, because you had to go and get it. You had to do some work to obtain it? Of course it's still a gift! You did NOTHING to earn the one million dollars. You did NOTHING to make the man give you the money. He just gave it to you freely!

Well, likewise, you did NOTHING to make God send Jesus to die for you. His sinless death was a FREE gift from God. But if you want it, you're going to have to go and get the gift. You're going have to DO something! And you know what you gotta do? The works of love! The 10LC! Those works of love are the evidence of your faith. Those works of love are the proof of your repentance. Remember, it's your repentance FOR God's forgiveness of sins. So if you'll DO THAT, live by the 10LC, you will obtain the free gift of eternal life.

And here's the deal ... your ENTIRE LIFE is the journey of going to get that gift. It won't stop until the day you take your last breath. And if on that day you are found faithfully fighting the GOOD fight of faith, living by the 10LC, then you will most assuredly receive the free gift of eternal life through Christ's death. This is why Jesus said, "Narrow is the WAY that leads to eternal life" (Matthew 7:14). See, it's a WAY. It's a JOURNEY that leads to eternal life, and that journey is the way of love, keep God's 10LC.

Well, Paul's phrase "the free gift" makes sense now, doesn't it? It's so simple. The SE clears it up immediately! Isn't it amazing how the SE is making sense of ALL Bible verses about salvation, grace, faith, repentance, love, etc? I mean seriously, if each verse in the Bible about "how to obtain eternal life" were a puzzle piece, we'd know where they all fit. We don't have to shy away from any Bible verse. We can snap them all together perfectly, and you know what the final picture would be? The beautiful SE!!! Praise the Lord!

Warning!

So listen, I want you to keep an eye out for preachers today using this "free gift" phrase, in an effort to get you to believe you don't have to do ANYTHING to make heaven. And specifically, they REALLY want you to believe "living by the 10LC" is not necessary! They are demons! They are lying to you! They don't know how all scriptures on salvation fit together, because they don't know the SE. So they love to use the "free gift" phrase, and make up lines about it, for what you need to do to go to heaven, like "All you need to do is receive the free gift of pardon", or "Just accept the free gift of salvation." These sneaky sentences are NOT in the Bible! And therefore, they leave people confused and bewildered about what they REALLY need to do to go to heaven.

And as I said before, in part 6 of this series, these same preachers will NEVER speak the simple words of Jesus Christ in their salvation pitch, "If you want to obtain eternal life, KEEP the 10LC". In other words, make the journey of faith that leads to you obtaining the free gift of

eternal life. It's really sad these preachers can't say Christ's words. It's tragic! So watch out for them. Don't let them deceive you about what you need to be doing to obtain eternal life! You go and get that gift of eternal life, just as the SE reveals.

If You Believe Jesus Died and Rose Again

If You Believe Jesus Died

"If you believe Jesus died and rose again" is a salvation doctrine found in Protestant churches today. It goes like this ... If you just believe Jesus died for your sins and rose again, you're saved. That's it. That's the faith or belief you have to have to go to heaven. Wow, this is a terrible lie! No one in the Bible believed that, not Jesus, not Paul, not any of the Apostles, and yet this lie persists today. I was even taught this doctrine growing up in different protestant churches. But on the Sabbath morning of December 8, 2007, everything changed! For that was the morning I awoke to a voice telling me all about God's salvation message behind the story of the Israelite's bondage in Egypt, deliverance through Moses, and wilderness journey to a Promise Land. And for the first time in my life I knew I had been lied to, my whole life in church, about salvation.

I instantly knew that "believing Jesus died for our sins and rose again" was NOT what we needed to do to go to heaven. In fact, it wasn't needed at all! I immediately knew the Salvation Equation (SE), and that OUR ENTIRE DUTY in obtaining eternal life was to DO Term A, which was to live by God's 10LC, exactly as Jesus had answered in the Gospels. (I'm going to tell you the meaning behind the Israelite's story in the conclusion, or part 12, of this series!) But for now, let's talk a little more about this erroneous salvation doctrine — If you believe Jesus died for you, you're going to heaven.

Looking at our SE, this is like saying ... ALL you have to DO to go to heaven is find out about Term B (what God had to do so we might have eternal life) and then you just have to mentally believe he did His part. This is ridiculous! This immediately begs the question ... well then what happens to the millions of people on earth who never got to hear anything about the story of Jesus? How do they get to heaven? Oh, don't worry about that, they'll tell you. God will figure that out. Just believe our doctrine! How stupid.

Believe Means Obey

See, somehow the idea got started that the word "believe" in the New Testament means to believe in what Jesus DID for us, meaning died and rose again. For example, I was taught my whole life that the word "believe" in John 3:16 meant ... "if I believe Jesus died for me, I will obtain everlasting life." You know the verse:

"For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten son, that whosoever believes in him should not perish, but have everlasting life" ([John 3:16](#))

See, I was always told this meant “believe he died for me”. But this isn’t true! The Greek word translated “believe” in John 3:16 is the same one used all over the New Testament for “believe,” and just 20 verses later in John 3:36 we see it used again. But this time we get the opposite to “believe not” used in the same verse, and guess what the Greek word for “believeth not” means? The word is “apeitheo,” and it means: to disobey! In other words, the word “believe” means to OBEY. So every time you see the phrase “believe in the son” “believe in Jesus” “believeth in him” “believe in his name,” it always means the same thing ... it means to OBEY Jesus, which means to OBEY his teachings. And we’ve already learned ALL his teachings were based on keeping the 10LC. So, in other words, to “believe in him” means to “keep the 10LC”.

So, for example, in the book of Acts, a jailor asked Paul & Silas: “What must I do to be saved?” (Acts 16:30) And they replied: “Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved!” (Acts 16:31). Friend, this is the same Greek Word used here for “believe” that was used in John 3:16 and John 3:36. It means to OBEY Jesus! Paul & Silas were saying “Obey Jesus’ teachings” and you will be saved. In other words, “keep the 10LC” and you will be saved. See, there’s no contradiction here with Christ’s words: “If you want to obtain eternal life, keep the 10LC”. And of course, this all agrees with the verse: “Jesus became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that OBEY him” (Hebrews 5:9). So let it forever be known, to BELIEVE in Jesus means to OBEY him, which means to KEEP the 10LC.

Misunderstood Verses

So let’s look now at some Scriptures where it might have got started that to “believe in Jesus” means something other than to believe in what he taught. One time Jesus told the Pharisees:

“If you do not believe that I am he, you will die in your sins” ([John 8:24](#))

Christ’s words here go back to God’s prophecy through Moses about the coming Messiah, THE PROPHET who was to come. Moses had said this: “The Lord your God will raise up a prophet from among you, from your fellow Israelites, like unto me, you must listen to him in everything he tells you. And it shall come to pass, that every soul, which will not heed his words, shall be destroyed” (Acts 3:22-23, Deuteronomy 18:15-19). Do you see? It was ALL about OBEYING the Messiah’s teachings. That was the important thing about THE Prophet to come. And Jesus was that prophet! Jesus was the Messiah. But the Pharisees HATED his teachings. Why? Because he preached obedience to the 10LC, and they didn’t keep them! They were full of pride and covetousness. They carried God’s name in vain. They were thieves who dishonored their parents, and on and on. And so Jesus was saying to them: if you don’t believe that I am he, the one in whom you need to obey, you will die in your sins! So this passage is the same thing again — if you don’t keep the 10LC, you will perish.

Then there’s Paul’s words in Romans — and we here this one continually today! — as follows:

“If thou shall confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus, and shall believe in your heart that God has raised him from the dead, you shall be saved” ([Romans 10:9](#))

This sounds like if we just say with our mouth, “I believe Jesus is Lord, and that he’s risen from the grave” we’re going to heaven. But Jesus said, “Why do you call me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ when you don’t DO what I say?” (Luke 6:46). Friend, it’s like this ... if you rent a house from a landlord, and his rules are no pets and no smoking in his house, you must abide by those rules because he is your Lord. If you don’t, he will kick you out of his house, and then he will NOT be your Lord. So this is how it is with Jesus, you must follow his rules or else he’s not your Lord! And those rules are the 10LC. So just confessing “Jesus is Lord” with your mouth is meaningless if you’re not living by the 10LC. So these words from Paul are also saying the same thing, the ONLY PEOPLE who can TRULY confess Jesus is Lord, are those who have made him their Lord by living by his teachings, the 10LC. So this verse is in perfect agreement with everything we’ve learned so far. And it’s also in agreement with Christ’s words: “Not everyone who calls me, ‘Lord, Lord’ will enter the kingdom of heaven, but only those who DO the will of my Father will enter” (Matthew 7:21). And friend, the will of the Father is for you to love, to keep the 10LC.

Warning!

So listen, I just want you to be aware of this satanic deception, that somehow just mentally believing that “Jesus died for you and rose again” is going to get you into heaven. It’s not! It’s a lie! And reciting some sinner’s prayer to that effect will be just as meaningless on Judgment Day. Things like, “Father, I believe you sent your son Jesus to die for my sins. And I believe he rose again. And I confess with my mouth he is Lord. And so right now, I declare, I am saved!” Have you ever heard these prayers? I have, my whole life! And yet you know what? They’re just a deception that takes the light off of the Biblical truth of what we REALLY must do to obtain eternal life. The ONLY THING that’s going to count on Judgment Day is whether or not you lived your life by the 10LC or not.

So I’m just here to warn you ... don’t be deceived about YOUR DUTY in obtaining eternal life for your soul. It has always been and always will be Term A in the SE. Repent of your sins! Turn from doing evil to doing good! Keep the 10LC. Do as Paul taught: “Work out your own salvation with fear and trembling” (Philippians 2:12). And don’t let anyone try and confuse you over Paul’s words in his letters. Paul knew the truth! And he declared it openly — Live right, and you’ll go to heaven, don’t, and you won’t! Remember, it was Paul who said: “For it is not those who hear the law who are righteous in God’s sight, but it is those who OBEY the LAW (the 10LC) who will be declared righteous” (Romans 2:13). So there you have it, now just go and do it.

Have You Accepted Jesus as Your Savior

Who Accepts Who

Have you ever heard this line ... “Have you accepted Jesus Christ as your personal savior?” If you’ve been in church, I know you have. This is all I heard growing up. This is the foundational salvation doctrine of protestant churches today. If you ask a preacher, “What must I DO to

obtain eternal life?” You’ll likely hear, “You need to accept Jesus as your savior”. But what is that? What does that mean? Let’s look closer at this phrase.

Would you believe this phrase is NOWHERE in the Scriptures. There’s no such thing as “accept Jesus” in God’s Word. Do you want to know the truth about the word “accept” in the Bible? It’s ALWAYS the other way around ... it’s GOD who ACCEPTS you ... but ONLY after you begin doing Term A in the SE. In other words, once you repent, or turn from sin, meaning keep the 10LC, then GOD will accept YOU! Let’s look at some examples in God’s Word:

“I now realize God shows no favoritism, but He ACCEPTS from every nation the one who fears Him and does what is right” ([Acts 10:34-35](#))

“Therefore we labor that we may be accepted of Him. For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that everyone may be recompensed for the things done in his body, according to what he has done, whether it be good or bad” (II Corinthians 5:9-10)

“Thus saith the Lord unto this people, Thus have they loved to wander, they have not refrained their feet, therefore the LORD doth NOT accept them; he will now remember their iniquity, and visit their sins” ([Jeremiah 14:10](#))

“Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in thy sight, O LORD, my strength, and my redeemer” ([Psalms 19:14](#))

“I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service. And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God” ([Romans 12:1-2](#))

“For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost. For he that in these things serveth Christ is acceptable to God” ([Romans 14:17-18](#))

“That we may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and honesty. For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Saviour” ([I Timothy 2:2-3](#))

“Wherefore, we receiving a kingdom which cannot be moved, let us have grace, whereby we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear” ([Hebrews 12:28](#))

See who does the accepting in every case? It’s GOD! But only after we decide to clean up our life and live by his 10LC. It’s that simple. Even from the very beginning, God delivered this message of acceptance to mankind. After seeing Cain become angry with his brother Abel, God told Cain:

“If you do what is right, will you not be accepted? But if you do not do what is right, sin is crouching at your door: for it desires to have you, but you must rule over it” ([Genesis 4:7](#))

Wow! See, when Adam & Eve ate from the tree of the knowledge of Good & Evil, they learned the 10LC. All mankind has known them. And God was telling Cain, if you keep them, meaning do what is right, I'll accept you! But if you don't, sin is going to destroy you! So listen, friend ... God has been perfectly fair to all mankind, from the beginning of Creation till now. No one has not known THEIR duty in obtaining eternal life! It has always been, and always will be Term A in the SE, rule over sin in your life by choosing to live by God's 10LC.

Warning!

So in summary, you're going to find there's about a dozen times the Bible talks about God accepting us after we choose to live righteously, and you're going to find there's not a single time the Bible talks about us accepting God, or accepting Jesus. It's just not there. And who do we know is the master at twisting/flipping God's Word? The devil! Satan! And I'm convinced it's Satan who has created this “accept Jesus” phrase to hide the Biblical truth of what WE really must DO to go to heaven!

Now you might say, “Ah, come on Gabe, you're just splitting hairs, right?” But am I really? Listen, once Satan has coined a non-biblical phrase, it leaves room for massive deception to take place. Why? Because who gets to define it? How does anyone know what it really means when it's not in Scripture? And then Satan's game is to have his ministers popularize this new phrase by using it over and over again, so it becomes so well-known in the church world that it's universally accepted as the truth. And at that point, no one can question it without being called a heretic. But seriously, what does it mean to “accept Jesus” as your personal savior? What is that? How do you do that? You know what I was told growing up in church? This is talking about the one-time experience you have walking up in front of a church somewhere and saying the sinner's prayer. You know, where you recite you believe Jesus died for your sins and rose again, and that you're now saved! That's it! Now you've “accepted Jesus”.

Forgive me, but what a joke! Can you see the deception in this? This is not going to hold an ounce of water on Judgment Day. This encounter of “accepting Jesus” is supposed to make you feel now like you are on good terms with God. But in reality, it's just masking the REAL TRUTH of God's Word, which says the ONLY way you are on good terms with God is if you make the decision to live by His 10LC. See, it's like a magician that shows you his one hand, when the truth of what's REALLY taking place is in his other hand behind his back. This is what this “accept Jesus” doctrine is like. Satan is dangling this phrase out there to you, while the REAL truth of what you need to do to make heaven is being hid behind his back, out of your sight and knowledge. And churchianity today is performing Satan's trick! They don't want to put the focus on “keeping the 10LC” as what YOU need to do to go to heaven. No way! They won't speak that! Even though Jesus said that very thing in their Bibles, they don't believe it and they don't want to hear it. So they'll say anything instead, even if it's not in the Bible ... like if you “accept Jesus” you'll go to heaven.

Here's the honest truth ... this phrase, "Have you accepted Jesus as your personal savior" should die! It should NEVER be spoken AGAIN in church! If someone asks a preacher, "What must I DO to obtain eternal life?" ... the first and foremost words they should speak are the words of Jesus Christ, "If you want to obtain eternal life, keep the 10LC". See how clear that would be? There's no confusion in those words. There's no nebulousness. No ambiguity. Nothing non-biblical and made up. It's just the clear and simple truth of God's Word that any person can understand. "Oh, I need to live right if I want to go to heaven, ok, thanks pastor!"


And then they should be teaching people God's 10LC. Talk about them in depth. Teach how ALL sin is based on disobedience to them, and how ALL love is based on obedience to them. How all of Jesus' teachings were based on them, every parable, every story, and every direct teaching on the law, when he was instructing us on how to live to obtain eternal life. This is what we're doing here at 10LC Ministries! We're obeying Jesus' final commission to his Apostles

"Go and make disciples of all nations ... and teach them to obey everything I have commanded" ([Matthew 28:19-20](#))

Friend, EVERYTHING Jesus commanded was based on keeping the 10LC. Jesus wants us to love! And why? Because if we'll do that, we'll be doing OUR PART in the SE, Term A, and that will yield us eternal life.

So, in closing, please be on guard for this "Have you accepted Jesus" phrase, for I fear the only thing these people have accepted is a false sense of eternal security. No one's telling them the PLAIN TRUTH of what they must do to make heaven. So watch out!

Can You Lose Your Salvation / OSAS



Can You Lose Your Salvation

Two hotly debated issues in the church world today are "Can you lose your salvation" and the doctrine of "Once saved always saved (O.S.A.S.)" And yet, if one understands the Salvation Equation (SE), it's simple to get to the truth behind these issues. Let's take a look at the equation and consider the question, "Can you lose your salvation?"

When you understand OUR ENTIRE DUTY in obtaining eternal life is to DO Term A, which is to continually live by God's 10LC, it becomes obvious this is something we can do for awhile and then quit. In other words, we can be saved for awhile, on our way to heaven, but then later we can turn back to living a life of willful sin, where we'll no longer be saved, but we'll be on our way to hell. So the correct answer to the question "Can you lose your salvation?" is a resounding ... YES!!! If we stop doing our part in the SE, we will have lost our salvation. And the Bible clearly confirms this truth! Peter said:

"For if after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, they are again entangled therein, and overcome, the latter end is worse with them than the beginning. For it had been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, then, after they have known it, to turn from the holy commandments delivered unto them. But it is happened unto them according to the true proverb, The dog is turned to his own vomit again; and the sow that was washed to her wallowing in the mire" ([II Peter 2:20-22](#))

Wow! How about that? Not only can you lose your salvation, but your punishment on Judgment Day will get worse! Now that's the Biblical truth of someone who lives a holy life for awhile, keeping the 10LC, and then turns away from them later! Peter said they are like a dog who returns to its vomit, or like a washed pig who returns to wallow in the mud. Nothing sadder could happen to a person, for they are in big trouble!

Parable of the Sower

Jesus' parable of the sower also confirms we can lose our salvation. The parable talks about four different heart responses to God's message of ... "If you want to obtain eternal life, keep the 10LC". There's a way side heart, a thorny heart, a stony heart, and a good soil heart. And it's the thorny and stony hearted people who lose their salvation, because they eventually stop living by God's 10LC. Jesus explained:

"The seed on stony soil represents those who hear the message and immediately receive it with joy. But since they have no root, they last only a short time. For when trouble or persecution comes because of the word, they quickly fall away" ([Mark 4:16-17](#))

See these people were excited about eternal life. They walked the way of God's 10LC for awhile, which means they were saved, and if they would have died then, they would have made heaven. But unfortunately, hardships came and people began laughing at them for living a self-sacrificing life of love, as defined by the 10LC, and so they stopped. And that's when stony-hearted people lose their salvation! And concerning thorny hearts, Jesus said:

"The seed that fell among thorns represent those who hear God's Word, but all too quickly the message is crowded out by the worries of this life, the lure of wealth, and the lust for other things, so no fruit is produced" ([Mark 4:18-19](#)).

Friend, the fruit Jesus is talking about is the good fruit of love, the 10LC. Thorny-hearted people can't continue walking the way of God's 10LC, because that requires them to be dead to this world, to hate money, to lose their life, etc ... but they are enticed to be prideful, to idolize money and materialistic things, to lust for dirt, and these desires choke out the humble fruit of love in their life. Visit ["The Commandments"](#) pages on our 10LC website and you'll learn how these desires are the root cause of ALL disobedience to God's 10LC, and without a doubt, they will strangle out a heart's ability to love. Thorny-hearted people are destined to lose their salvation.

By the way, in this parable of the sower, do you see how once again Jesus is making it crystal clear that Term A in the SE is OUR DUTY in obtaining eternal life? Friend, this parable is about eternal life! Only those who produce the good fruit of love in their life, which is to keep the 10LC, will obtain eternal life. And in the parable Jesus is explaining the reasons WHY people will NOT live by the 10LC! He's exposing their hearts! And only the hearts having good ground will obtain eternal life, for they will cherish Jesus' teachings and produce the good fruit of love. What an amazing parable!

Ezekiel the Prophet

Even in the Old Testament God plainly reveals we can lose our salvation. Speaking through the prophet Ezekiel, God said:

“If a righteous person turns to sinning and acts like any other sinner, should he be allowed to live? No, of course not! All his previous goodness will be forgotten, and he shall die for his sins” ([Ezekiel 18:24](#))

Wow! How about those words? Of course we can lose our salvation! Friend, you can live righteously for decades, but if for whatever reason you eventually turn from the 10LC and begin living in willful sin, you will go to hell! Your past righteousness will be forgotten, and you will die in your sins! Man, that's humbling! Friend, you have got to get on the path of God's 10LC, and NEVER turn from them, if you want to make heaven! Anything less is like playing Russian roulette with your eternal destiny! And trust me ... you don't want to play that game! God says:

“Do you think I like to see the wicked die? Of course not! I only want him to turn from his wicked ways and live ... If a wicked person turns away from his wickedness and obeys the law, and does what is right, he shall save his soul” ([Ezekiel 18:23,27](#))

Are You Saved?

In light of the Salvation Equation's truth, do you now recognize the ambiguity behind this ubiquitous church question ... “Are you saved?” What in the world are they asking? If they're talking about term “B” (what Jesus did to make “forgiveness of sins” available for our salvation) of course we are! Everyone in the world is saved in that regard, whether they know about Jesus'

story or not. Do you understand? Your knowledge of Jesus' story, your belief in his story or lack of belief in his story, can NOT change the fact that "forgiveness of sins" is available to you. In other words, God's part in salvation is secure! It is an unchangeable fact! So, if a person is referring to term "B" in the Salvation Equation when asking the question "Are you saved?" the answer is ALWAYS, "Yes!" It's actually an idiotic question in that regard.

Now, if the person is referring to term "A" in the Salvation Equation when asking "Are you saved?" the correct answer should be ... "Well, (ma'am or sir), I'm actively working on that day second by second, hour by hour, day by day of my life, by always striving to live a repentant lifestyle of keeping God's 10 Love Commandments. I'm laboring to be accepted of God. I'm working out my own salvation, daily, with fear and trembling. I'm resisting the devil, fighting the good fight of faith, doing Term A in the SE, so that I might receive the forgiveness for sins Christ made available to me by dying on the cross! Please pray I continue in this manner, and yes, I hope God will accept me into His Kingdom one day." Do you see the humility in that answer? Do you see this person TRULY knows what THEY MUST DO to obtain salvation (eternal life)? How smart. How wise! How repentant!

But we all know what a modern day churchgoer is getting at with this "Are you saved?" question, don't we? It stems from incorrect salvational doctrine. They think what a person MUST DO to obtain eternal life is learn about term "B" (what Jesus did) and then "believe that story" in their heart to be true. If you do this, they think, that is ALL you have to do to obtain eternal life. That belief usually accompanies a trip to a church altar somewhere, followed by a few prayerful words. Then, that's it! You're saved forever! That, my friend, is probably Satan's most damnable lie he tells in today's church world! I urge you to expose this lie every chance you get, pointing people to this website if you must. Let's help our brothers and sisters learn the TRUTH about salvation, giving them an honest chance at obtaining eternal life. And let's give the devil one big old black eye!

Once Saved Always Saved

So what about this doctrine of "Once saved always saved (OSAS)"? Is it true? I think you know by now, right? Of course not! It's a massive lie from Satan! There's NOTHING you can possibly do at just ONE TIME in your life that then guarantees your entrance into heaven. That doctrine is demonic. The ONLY thing you can do to make heaven is CONTINUALLY strive to live by God's 10LC. It's a lifetime journey. And if you ever stop living righteously, and die in that condition, you'll perish. So don't believe this satanic doctrine of OSAS. It was invented by Satan for people who do not understand the truth of God's Word concerning what WE must DO to obtain eternal life. God says:

"Repent, and turn from your sins while there is yet time. Put them behind you and make you a new heart and a new spirit. For I have no pleasure in seeing you die, says the Lord God. So turn yourselves and live!" ([Ezekiel 18:30-32](#))

Now that's the truth! Believe the words of God, people, and reject all demonic doctrines in today's churches.

Other Bible Phrases Equal to “Keep 10LC”

Other Bible Phrases

There are many other ways the Bible has to express term “A” in the Salvation Equation. In other words, there are many well known Biblical phrases that simply mean to “keep God’s 10 Love Commandments”. This is really going to enlighten you. We’ve compiled a list of over 30 phrases in the Bible that are directly equal in meaning to “keep the 10LC”. In other words, these phrases are correct answers to the question of “What must I DO to obtain eternal life?” Let’s look at our Salvation Equation (SE) again, and I’ll explain what I mean.

As we know, Term A in the equation is OUR DUTY in obtaining eternal life. And in part 3 of this series we learned that that is to repent of sin, which is to turn from doing evil to doing good, which is best said as simply “Keep the 10LC”. So since these new phrases are equal in meaning to “keep the 10LC”, then obviously they are correct answers to the question of what WE must DO to obtain eternal life. The only downfall is ... if you use these phrases in answer to that question, usually the person you’re talking to will not understand the phrase means to “keep the 10LC”. So they’ll just be confused.

So please understand, the VERY BEST answer, at ALL times, to the question “What Must I Do to Obtain Eternal Life” is Jesus’ answer, “If you want to obtain eternal life, Keep the 10LC”. This is clear cut and simple to understand. Although, I will say ... most people today don’t FULLY understand the 10 Commandments, either. They don’t realize the 10 Commandments are the COMPLETE instructions for love! So for example, they don’t know forgiveness, giving, and contentment are a part of the 10LC. Why is this? It’s because they don’t understand each commandment has a don’t and a do side, covering all love when obeyed, and all sin when disobeyed.

So, in reality, people STILL DO need taught many things about the 10LC. Shame on the church today for not understanding and teaching these simplest of things! Shame on them for not knowing ALL of Jesus’ teachings are based on keeping the 10LC! So, sadly, we still have A LOT of work to do to get people up to speed with God’s Word. There’s a famine in the land today for the truth of God’s Word. And I encourage you to visit [“The Commandments”](#) pages on our 10LC website, and learn everything about God’s 10LC. It will set you free!

Ok, so with that said, let’s take a look at these other Bible phrases that are equal in meaning to “keep the 10LC”. This is really going to help you understand the Bible, for as you encounter these phrases while reading, you’ll now know their REAL meaning, and everything is going to start making sense to you. Bring Forth Fruits of Repentance:

“Bring forth therefore fruits worthy of repentance, and begin not to say within yourselves, We have Abraham to our father: for I say unto you, That God is able of these stones to raise up children unto Abraham. And now also the axe is laid unto the root of the trees: every tree therefore which bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire. And the people asked him, saying, What shall we do then? He answered and saith unto them, He that hath two coats, let him impart to him that hath none: and he that hath meat, let him do likewise. Then came also publicans to be baptized, and said unto him, Master, what shall we do? And he said unto them, Exact no more than that which is appointed you. And the soldiers likewise demanded of him, saying, And what shall we do? And he said unto them, Do violence to no man, neither accuse any falsely; and be content with your wages” ([Luke 3:8-14](#))

Believe in Jesus: (())

“For he (Jesus) whom God hath sent speaketh the words of God: For God giveth not the Spirit by measure unto him. The Father loveth the Son, and hath given all things into his hand. He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that obeys not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him” ([John 3:34-36](#))

Know God:

“And hereby we do know that we know Him (God), if we keep His commandments. He that saith, I know Him, and keepeth not His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him” ([1 John 2:3-4](#))

Know the Truth:

“Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed: And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free” ([John 8:31-32](#))

Work Righteousness:

“But in every nation he that feareth Him, and worketh righteousness, is accepted with Him” ([Acts 10:35](#))

Doer of the Word:

“Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls. But be ye doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves. For if any be a hearer of the word, and not a doer, he is like unto a man beholding his natural face in a glass: For he beholdeth himself, and goeth his way, and straightway forgetteth what manner of man he was. But whoso looketh into the perfect law of liberty, and continueth therein, he being not a forgetful hearer, but a doer of the work, this man shall be blessed in his deed. If any man among you seem to be religious, and bridleth not his tongue, but deceiveth his own heart, this man’s religion is vain. Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and the widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world” ([James 1:21-27](#))

Run the Race:

“Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us” ([Hebrews 12:1](#))

Build House on Rock:

“Therefore whoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock: And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not; for it was founded upon a rock. And every one that heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them not, shall be likened unto a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand: And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell: and great was the fall of it” ([Matthew 7:24-27](#))

Fear God:

“But the mercy of the Lord is from everlasting to everlasting upon them that fear Him, and His righteousness unto children’s children; to such as keep His covenant, and to those that remember His commandments to do them” ([Psalms 103:17-18](#))

Fight the Good Fight of Faith:

“But thou, O man of God, flee these things; and follow after righteousness, godliness, faith, love, patience, meekness. Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses” ([I Timothy 6:11-12](#))

Obey the Gospel of Jesus Christ:

“And to you who are troubled rest with us, when the Lord Jesus shall be revealed from heaven with his mighty angels, in flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God, and that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ: Who shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord, and from the glory of his power; when he shall come to be glorified in his saints, and to be admired in all them that believe (because our testimony among you was believed) in that day. Wherefore also we pray always for you, that our God would count you worthy of this calling, and fulfill all the good pleasure of His goodness, and the work of faith with power: That the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you, and ye in him, according to the grace of God and the Lord Jesus Christ” ([II Thessalonians 1:7-12](#))

Put on the Whole Armor of God:

“Finally my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; and your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and with supplication for all saints” ([Ephesians 6:10-18](#))

Work Out Your Own Salvation:

“Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling” ([Philippians 2:12](#))

Do Truth:

“And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. For ever one that doeth evil hateth the light, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reproved. But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in God” ([John 3:19-21](#))

Bear Good Fruit:

“For a good tree bringeth not forth corrupt fruit; neither doth a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit. For every tree is known by his own fruit. For of thorns men do not gather figs, nor of a bramble bush gather they grapes. A good man out of the good treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart bringeth forth that which is evil: for of the abundance of the heart his mouth doth speaketh. And why call ye me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say?” ([Luke 6:43-46](#))

Abide in Christ:

“I AM the true vine, and my Father is the husbandman. Every branch in me that beareth not fruit He taketh away: and every branch that beareth fruit, He purgeth it, that it may bring forth more fruit. Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you. Abide in me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, except ye abide in me. I am the vine, ye are the branches: he that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for without me ye can do nothing. If a man abide not in me, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast them into the fire, and they are burned. If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you. Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples. As the Father hath loved me, so have I loved you: continue ye in my love. If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father’s commandments, and abide in His love. Be Perfect:

“Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect” ([Matthew 5:48](#))

Doer of the Law:

“For as many as have sinned without law shall also perish without law: and as many as have sinned in the law shall be judged by the law; For not the hearers of the law are just before God, but the doers of the law shall be justified” ([Romans 2:12-13](#))

Be Wise:

“A wise man feareth, and departeth from evil; but the fool rageth, and is confident” ([Proverbs 14:16](#))

Be Blessed:

“Blessed are they that do His commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city” ([Revelation 22:14](#))

Walk in the Holy Spirit:

“This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh. For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would. But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law. Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God. But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance: against such there is no law. And they that are Christ’s have crucified the flesh with the affections and lusts. If we live in

the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. Let us not be desirous of vain glory, provoking one another, envying one another” ([Galatians 5:16-26](#))

Do the Will of God:

“Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever” ([1 John 2:15-17](#))

Let Your Light Shine:

“Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hid. Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven” ([Matthew 5:14-16](#))

Resist the Devil:

“Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ye double minded. Be afflicted, and mourn, and weep: let your laughter be turned to mourning, and your joy to heaviness. Humble yourselves in the sight of the Lord, and He shall lift you up” ([James 4:7-10](#))

Love Jesus:

“If ye love me, keep my commandments. Defile Not the Temple:

“And he (Jesus) said, That which cometh out of the man, that defileth the man. For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornication, murders, thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness: All these evil things come from within, and defile the man” ([Mark 7:20-23](#))

Depart from Evil:

“Come, ye children, hearken unto me: I will teach you the fear of the Lord. What man is he that desireth life, and loveth many days, that he may see good? Keep thy tongue from evil, and thy lips from speaking guile. Depart from evil, and do good; seek peace, and pursue it. The eyes of the Lord are upon the righteous, and His ears are open unto their cry. The face of the Lord is against them that do evil, to cut off the remembrance of them from the earth. The righteous cry, and the Lord heareth, and delivereth them out of all their troubles. The Lord is nigh unto them that are of a broken heart; and saveth such as be of a contrite spirit. Many are the afflictions of the righteous: but the Lord delivereth him out of them all. He keepeth all his bones: not one of them is broken. Evil shall slay the wicked: and they that hate the righteous shall be desolate. The Lord redeemeth the soul of His servants: and none of them that trust in Him shall be desolate” ([Psalms 34:11-22](#))

Be Sober and Vigilant:

“Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour” ([1 Peter 5:8](#))

The Patience of the Saints:

“Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus” ([Revelation 14:12](#))

Hope for Salvation:

“Lord, I have hoped for thy salvation, and done thy commandments.” ([Psalms 119:166](#))

Be Born of God:

“We know that whosoever is born of God sinneth not; but he that is begotten of God keepeth himself, and that wicked one toucheth him not” ([1 John 5:18](#))

The Law and the Prophets:

“Therefore all things whatsoever ye would that men should do to you, do ye even so to them: for this is the law and the prophets” ([Matthew 7:12](#))

The Whole Duty of Man:

“Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God, and keep His commandments: for this is the whole duty of man. For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil” ([Ecclesiastes 12:13-14](#))

Conclusion (The Exodus Parable)

The Exodus Parable

Congratulations everyone, you’ve made it to the conclusion of our Salvation Equation (SE) series! This is where we’re going to reveal God’s amazing message behind the Israelite’s story of bondage in Egypt, deliverance thru Moses, and wilderness journey to a Promise Land. It’s from this story that the SE equation was born. And it’s this story that the church today DESPERATELY needs to understand, so all demonic salvation doctrines will die. So let’s get right into it.

The first thing you need to understand is this story is a parable. Remember how Jesus loved to talk in parables? Jesus said, “I have not spoken on my own, but the Father who sent me has commanded me what to say and how to say it.” (John 12:49). In other words, friend, Jesus’ parables came from God! It is HE who is the creator of parables. And in the OT, many of the real-life stories that took place were being carefully controlled by God to be parables, delivering messages to mankind.

And this is the case with the story of the Israelites. In fact, it’s the mother of all parables in God’s Word! It’s the main story in the Bible! All 66 books in the Bible support its message. So what was the message? The parable reveals everything involved in mankind’s spiritual journey back to God. In other words, it will reveal everything it takes for a soul to obtain eternal life, and that truth is going to uncover the SE!

The Setup

Remember now, in a parable, things symbolize, or represent, other things! So here are the things in the Israelite parable and what they stand for: The kingdom of Egypt represents Satan’s kingdom of darkness, and Pharaoh himself represents

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Satan. The Promise Land represents Heaven, where eternal life exists, and the Israelites represent us, all of mankind. And Moses represents the coming Messiah, Jesus Christ!

So here's what happened, in the Garden of Eden Satan enticed Adam & Eve into sinning, and they immediately went into bondage to sin and death. All mankind would now be born into sin and its resulting death. In other words, Satan now held the power of death over mankind. And we had no hope of ever becoming free of this death penalty in our own power, for we would all sin, which left us no chance at obtaining eternal life in heaven. We were Satan's slaves!

So God created this same situation with the Israelites, by making them slaves in Egypt under Pharaoh's control. Oh, the Israelites longed to return to the Promise Land, but they had no hope of ever escaping Egypt to get there. Pharaoh and his army would kill them if they tried. In other words, Pharaoh held the power of death over the Israelites, just like Satan held the power of death over mankind. And Pharaoh would not let them go!

So you get it? God has this real life story, this parable, perfectly set up now to reveal EVERYTHING it will take for us, mankind, to make it to heaven and obtain eternal life. All we have to do is look and learn everything it takes for the Israelites to make it to the Promise Land in their story. It's that simple! It's the perfect parable. And it's amazing!

Moses & Red Sea Scene is Term B

So what happens first? God himself delivers the Israelites out of Egypt. He raises up a man named Moses, to work through, in order to free the Israelites. And long story short, at the Red Sea, God commands Moses to "stretch out his arms" while He miraculously divides the sea, saves the Israelites, and then destroys Pharaoh and his army. Do you get it? This is about Jesus! Remember, Moses represents the coming Messiah, Jesus, in this parable. And roughly 1300 years later, God raised up the man Jesus, to work through, having him "stretch out his arms" on a cross, while He miraculously divided the Temple Veil, saved mankind, and then destroyed Satan's power of death over us.

Friend, if you haven't figured it out yet, THIS is Term B in the SE. This was God's duty in helping us obtain eternal life. It was ALL God's doing! We had NO PART in it. The moment Jesus' sinless death came into existence, as he died on the cross, we were set free from the bondage of sin and death Satan had us under. Why? Because THIS was the righteous death that could now pay our death sentence for the sins we committed, which gave us a chance at obtaining eternal life in heaven. This was the free gift ... Jesus' death! This was God's grace. And now you know God's incredible salvation message behind Moses and the Red Sea scene in His parable of the Israelites.

But here's the kicker, that's not the end of the story. So let me ask you a question ... did God's miraculous deliverance of the Israelites AUTOMATICALLY place them in the Promise Land? No! All it did was put them in a POSITION to now BE ABLE to reach the Promise Land. Before they had no chance of that! So guess what they had to do now to reach and enter the Promise Land? They had to make a journey through the wilderness. And guess what the journey entailed? Obedience to the 10LC!!! This is why 50 days after the Exodus scene, God gathered the Israelites at the base of Mt Sinai and thunderously spoke and wrote the 10LC for them! And then He said:

"All the commandments which I command you this day shall you observe to do, that you may live, and go in and possess the Promise Land" ([Deuteronomy 8:1](#))

Wow! And if they didn't keep them:

"Not a single person of this evil generation will see the Promise Land" ([Deuteronomy 1:35](#))

Friend, do you get it? This is Term A in the SE! God is revealing here OUR DUTY in obtaining eternal life! It's a lifelong journey! We are to forsake sin and live by God's 10LC. If we'll do that, THEN Christ's death will be applied as the ransom payment for our sins, yielding us eternal life in heaven. It's that simple. And if we don't live by the 10LC, then we will perish in the lake of fire and never get to see heaven. Now you know why, when the man asked Jesus, "Teacher, what must I DO to obtain eternal life?" Jesus answered, "If you want to obtain eternal life, keep the 10LC"

(Matthew 19:17). See? Jesus was looking back and confirming God's salvation message in the "wilderness journey" portion of the Israelite's parable. It all makes perfect sense now, doesn't it? It's so simple!

Salvation Equation Revealed

The Israelite's story had it all. It's the SE! God had something to do, and we have something to do in order to obtain eternal life. And they are completely separate and independent of each other. So let me ask you question ... In the wilderness, did the Israelites have to "believe in the story of Moses at the Red Sea" to enter the Promise Land? No! The ONLY thing they had to do was choose to live by God's 10LC. Well, likewise, you don't need to believe in the story of Jesus on the cross, either, to make heaven. It's wonderful if you do, but it's not necessary! The ONLY thing you need to do is live by Jesus' teachings, the 10LC!

Listen, God's work through Moses was finished! It was a done deal. Pharaoh's power was destroyed, the Israelites were free, and the way to the Promise Land was wide open for them. Well, likewise, God's work through Jesus is finished! It's a done deal. Satan's power is destroyed, we're free, and the way to heaven is wide open for us! Millions of people have lived on this earth having never heard anything about the story of Jesus, and that's perfectly fine. You don't need to know that story to make heaven. You only need to live by the 10LC, and ALL mankind has known them, for they're wrapped up in the Golden Rule:

"Do unto others whatever you would want them to do unto you, for this is the essence of all that is taught in the law and the prophets" ([Matthew 7:12](#))

Wow! Friend, everyone knows when they are treating someone else in way that they themselves would not want to be treated. That's sin! That's no love! And that's the wide path most people take that leads to hell!

Well, friend THIS was the incredible message I received from God Dec 8, 2007, as I lay in my bed. I was overwhelmed! And yet, I'm only scratching the surface of all God told me about the Israelite's story. Then, a few months later, He revealed to me His mind-blowing message behind the story of Noah, the Ark and the global flood, which was another parable, but this one was about Christ's Second Coming! All these truths, and much more, are now written down in a book God commanded me to write in 2008 entitled: "[Undeniable Biblical Proof Jesus Christ Will Return to Planet Earth Exactly 2,000 Years After the Year of His Death](#)". If you REALLY want to know what the Bible is about, get that book and read it! It will change your life!

Well, that's it, friends! That's the SE! Hopefully, you'll go back now and study this entire series again, for if you do, I believe you'll REALLY get it! No one will be able to confuse you, ever again, about salvation. You'll be able to instantly spot confusion and deception in preacher's words. Which reminds me ... I need your help? Friend, we've got to get this SE information into the church. Preachers today desperately need to understand God's message behind the Israelite's story! So if you're a churchgoer, let your pastor know! If we can get this information out, I know it will help many people make heaven!
